1. Unsundered Blessings Block The Knock.

- **3 John 2** “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.”
- **Psalms 35:27** “Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”
- **1 Timothy 6:17** “...the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.”
- **Deuteronomy 28:2** “All these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you...”
- **Deuteronomy 28:1 (NKJV)** “If you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God...”
- **1 Timothy 6:18 (NKJV)** “Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share.”
- **3 John 2 (NKJV)** ... “Even as your soul prospers.”
- **Malachi 3:7 (NKJV)** Return to Me, and I will return to you, “Says the LORD of hosts.” But you said, ‘In what way shall we return?’

a) *Unsundered blessings blind us.*

- **Revelation 3:17** “Because you say, I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing...”
- **James 1:17** “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above...”
- **Deuteronomy 8:18** “You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth...”
- **Luke 12:20 (NKJV)** “You fool! This night your soul will be required of you.”

b) *Unsundered Blessings Change Our Spiritual Temperature.*

- **Matthew 22:37 (NKJV)** “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.”
- **Revelation 3:16** “Because you are lukewarm... I will vomit you out of My mouth.”
