

Mark 5:22-36 NKJV And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet 23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, “My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live.” 24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him. 25 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, “If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well.” 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction. 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, “Who touched My clothes?” 31 But His disciples said to Him, “You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, ‘Who touched Me?’” 32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. 34 And He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.” 35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue’s house who said, “Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?” 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, “Do not be afraid; only believe.”

Genesis 50:20 NKJV But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive.

Psalms 73:26 NKJV My flesh and my heart fail; But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Ephesians 2:4-5 NKJV But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ.

Acts 13:30 NKJV But God raised Him from the dead.

How can we experience ‘But God’ moments when all hope seems gone?

1. We Must Believe God Wants to Help Us.

- **Mark 5:24 NKJV** So Jesus went with him,
- **Pslam 121:1-2 NKJV** I will lift up my eyes to the hills—From whence comes my help? 2 My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.
- **Psalms 46:1 NKJV** God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.
- **Hebrews 4:16 NKJV** Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

2. We Must Believe God Can Be Touched.

- **Mark 5:27 NKJV** When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment.
- **Hebrews 4:15 KJV** For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

Notes:

 3. We Must Determine to Touch Jesus No Matter How Hopeless It Seems.

a) What We Say:

- **Mark 5:28** NKJV For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

b) What We Hold Onto:

- **Malachi 4:2** NKJV But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings.

c) What We Hear:

- **Mark 5:27** NKJV When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment.
- **Romans 10:17** NKJV So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- **James 1:3-4** NKJV knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

 4. We Must Believe Delays Are More Divine Than They Are Denials.

- **Mark 5:33** NKJV But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth
- **Revelation 12:11** NKJV And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony...

 5. We Must Sow the Right Seed So God Can Meet Our Need.

- **Romans 8:28** NKJV And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.
- **Galatians 6:7** NKJV Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

 6. We Must Trust God to Do What We Can't.

- **Mark 5:37-42** NKJV And He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John the brother of James. 38 Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and saw a tumult and those who wept and wailed loudly. 39 When He came in, He said to them, "Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping." 40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying. 41 Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, "Talitha, cumi," which is translated, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." 42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.
